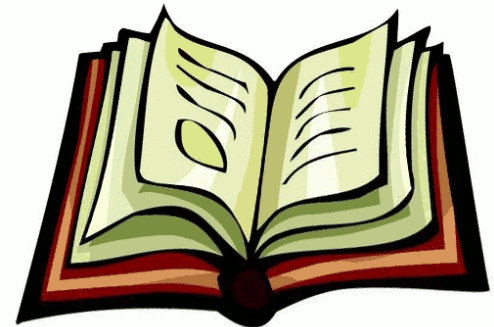


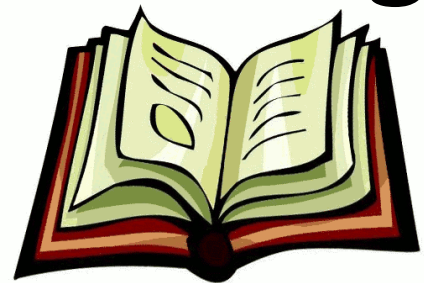
Romans 12:1

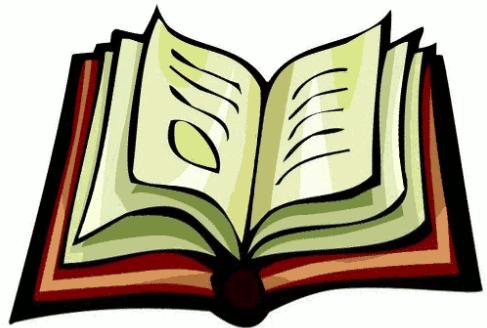
Romans 12:2

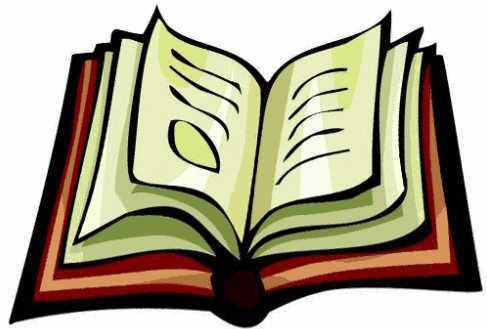
