Your **artwork** may be a drawing or painting or combination thereof and the surface must be flat, no collage. The required size is A3.

There will be **prizes** for the three winners in each category: 1st place. R1000; 2nd place—R500 and 3rd place—R750; as well as a cash prize of R3 000 for the school/ centre with the most entries.

Each artist who submits a valid entry will receive a **certificate of participation** after the final judging.

An art exhibition and prize-giving ceremony will take place on 8 Sept 2018 at Utopia Place, 840 Cura Ave., Pretoria, and all the participants are invited to attend a special morning together with his/ her parent(s) and grandparent(s). There will also be a guest artist.

Requirements

The teacher or parent is asked to mount the artwork on a prescribed colour as per age category, to attach the standard label (included in the entry form), placed in the bottom right corner. Please provide a title.

Final mounted size of the artwork should be A3. Cut 1 cm off the edges, **mount** the work on **card-board** of the following colour (the birth year of the child will serve as the category):

2015 (turns three) - Orange

2014 (turns four) - Yellow

2013 (turns five) - Red

2012 (turns six) - Green

The work should be that of the child alone and be produced in 2018. Artwork not adhering to the general criteria will not be considered. The decision of the judges is final, and no correspondence or negotiations will take place.

Please ensure that you take a photo of the artwork for your own use before submitting. The artwork will not be sent back to the artist, family or school. The organisers reserve the right to sell the art pieces to generate funds for the project.

The entry fee is R10 per artwork and the closing date for the competition is 31 July 2018.

The artworks can be submitted on 21 July 2018 at the VVOS/ AECYC Seminar in Pretoria.
