**Requirements:**

The artwork can consist of any representation of the theme. It can be a drawing of your grandparents or anything that makes you think of your granny or grandpa. Please provide the artwork of a title.

The artwork must be two-dimensional (2D) and may be a drawing, painting or collage or a combination thereof. The artwork surface must be flat.

The teacher or parent are asked to mount the artwork on a prescribed colour as per age category, to attach the standard label (included in the entry form), placed in the bottom right corner.

Final mounted size: A3

After cutting a strip of 1cm off the edges of the piece, mount the work on cardboard of the following colour (the birth year of the child will serve as the category):

2014 (turning three years) - Orange

2013 (turning four years) - Yellow

2012 (turning five years) - Red

2011 (turning six years) - Green

If preferred, the outline can be drawn with a black marking pen.

The work should be that of the child alone and be produced in 2017.

The **entry fee** is R10 per entry and is payable on submission.

**Entries:**

The artworks can be submitted between 7 and 9 am on **29 July 2017 at the AECYC Seminar** at UNISA in Pretoria, or at the AECYC office in Centurion. Please contact the office by phone (no. 012 667 2028) or e-mail (address [info@vvos.co.za](mailto:info@vvos.co.za)) to make an appointment.

All artwork should reach the AECYC office by 4 August 2017 to be taken into consideration for the competition.

Artwork that do not adhere to the general criteria will not be considered. The decision of the judges is final and no correspondence or negotiations will take place.

The artwork will not be sent back to the artist, family or school. Please ensure that you take a photo of the artwork for your own use before submitting. The organisers reserve the right to sell the art pieces to generate funds for the project
